



MEMBERSHIP FORM 2012

RULES OF MEMBERSHIP

This club is intended to give riders the opportunity to get full use out of their machines, plus a sense of achievement by winning trophies.

Club membership is open to anyone over the age of sixteen years, riding any capacity machine.

MEMBERSHIP OPENS from 1st November 2011 to 31st December 2012

MEMBERSHIP FEE for 2011/2012 will be £60.00 including VAT.

ENTRIES will be on the day except for special meetings.

RIDES: The club organises more than 52 meetings throughout the year for members to race in.

1. Membership will be limited to 500 riders per year. All riders must be over 16 years old.
2. The meetings will be up to six heats of three laps, then the riders will be graded into A,B,C,D,E,F groups for three legs. The number of groups is dependant on the quantity of entries.
3. Trophies will be awarded down to sixth place in all groups, when numbers are sufficient, i.e. over 80
4. The Main and Support championships are for A Group riders only. Specialist championships are open to all and are raced over three legs, consisting of one straight race and two handicaps with trophies on the day and at the year's end. The 125, 250 & 500 two stroke championship races are one-off 20 minute races at the start of the day, with trophies only awarded annually, after which competitors revert to their normal groups. All championship meetings have normal groups as well as the championship classes, except the Veterans Grand Prix (Over 40s only) and the ORPA British Clubmans Championships. Four stroke championships have two straight races and one handicap and are Junior only championships.
5. Camping facilities are available at no cost at most venues.
6. Riders will keep their allocated number throughout the year.
7. All riders will help dismantle the track, when necessary after meetings. Most tracks stay up permanently, but failure to help clear the occasional temporary track could result in loss of any trophy won on that day.
8. Tracks are situated in Sussex, Surrey and Hampshire. About seven tracks are available to the club during the course of the year.
9. Club Members must have an ORPA licence to race at SMX events.
10. Due to Personal Accident cover not being available at a reasonable rate from our insurers, it is recommended you take the CICA cover through Chris Cowell (Tel: 07712 579001)
